



How to view a course presentation and accompanying resources

Each course consists of a course presentation and accompanying resources. The course presentation is the main component, or lesson, that delivers topical information through a variety of media including text, pictures, audio and video. Additionally, a course may contain any number of accompanying resources to compliment and extend the course presentation. The accompanying resources may include files for course handouts or worksheets, video segments, quizzes, and discussion forums.

The following are the steps to viewing a course presentation and accompanying resources:

1. Once logged in, you will find a listing of your registered courses under the “Home” link. Click on a course title to view a listing of its course presentations and accompanying resources.

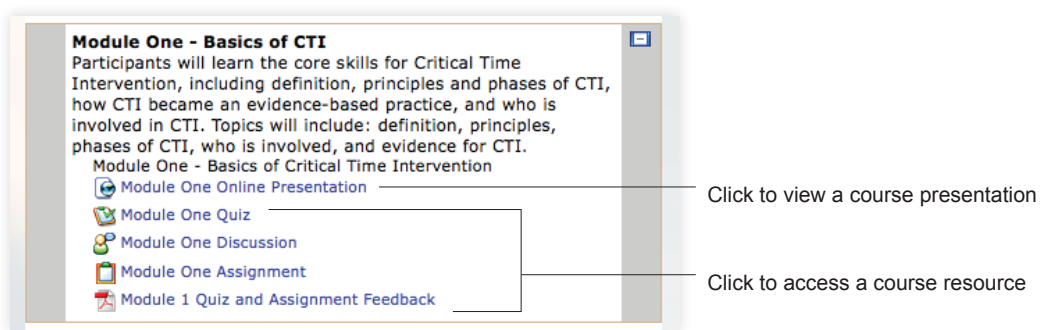

- In the course view, the middle of the screen will present the course module or modules. Each module will contain a listing of available course presentations and accompanying resources. To view a course presentation or to download or access an accompanying resource, click on the name of an item.



- A course presentation will automatically start playing when it is accessed. While it is playing, you may use the buttons on the accompanying control bar to pause, skip forward and back, adjust the volume, and view the presentation in full-screen mode. Additionally, the course presentation control bar contains a progress bar that shows how much of the presentation has loaded as well as your current location within the presentation.
